Floral Contract

By signing this contract you are agreeing to the following:

- To hold your event date on the official calendar, you must pay a 30% deposit. This deposit is non-refundable.
- The remaining floral balance must be paid 2 weeks before the event.
- All final changes to the order must be made by 2 weeks before the event.
- Failure to meet these 2-week requests can result in a change of flowers that I am able to get for your event. I have a much larger selection from my wholesalers the further out I order from the event. I will place the floral order when I receive your final payment.
- I cannot guarantee the flowers will be the exact color of your inspiration pictures, but I will order the closest color possible. Many times the Pinterest pictures I am given are edited, which causes false colors that are not actually grown. Filters and presets used by the photographer can create these colors.
- Not all flowers are available all year due to seasons. I will inform you if there are any needs for substitution.
- Your flowers will have the same look and feel as your inspiration. I will design the flowers to be as close to your inspiration pictures as possible, but cannot guarantee they will be an exact replication.
 - For an additional fee, I can make a trial bouquet and/or arrangement with your wedding flowers for your approval. This is only available until 30 days before your event to allow me time for changes in the order/quote if necessary.
- Payment for both the deposit and the remaining balance can be paid via cash, check, Venmo, or Paypal
- You have 2 weeks after receiving this quote to reach out to me for it to remain an active quote. This can include: adjustments to the order, agreeing to the quote and paying the deposit, or to let me know you no longer need my services. After this period I will open the date up for other quotes and you may lose your event date. I tentatively hold your date during the quote period, but it is only officially held with your deposit.
